April 24: Orders to Council are due. Units or individuals can submit their orders to the Council online beginning April 19.


May 18: Order distribution at the Scout Office in Weston.

Commonly Asked Questions

- O: Who can sell?
- A: Units, National Jamboree attendees and individual Scouts.
- Q: What if I decide to sell after the deadline?
- A: You can sign up for the sale, up until the day the sale starts on March 27.
- Q: Is there an online selling opportunity?
- A: Not at this time
- Q: How does the commission process work?
- A: Same as with the popcorn sale. Units or individuals keep the commission. The commission will be deducted from the amount owed to the Council and will be reflected in the unit or individual invoice.
- Q: What type of communication should we expect to receive from the Council?
- A: Weekly emails will be sent out once the sale starts. You will receive a confirmation email after you have signed up.
- Q: How does the ordering process work?
- A: Units can submit their orders online to the Council. An online system will be available on our website April 19. Units will be notified when this system is live through the weekly email.
- Q: When should customers pay?
- A: The unit or individual can decide whether money should be collected up front or upon delivery.
- Q: When are unit checks cashed?
- A: Checks can be postdated to June 12. One check made out to "Samoset Council." That is the day checks will be cashed.
- Q: Do we have to drive to Wausau to pick up the order?
- A: We will make every attempt to work with units or individuals not in the Wausau area to deliver orders. Proximity to the Council office **should not** be a deterrent to units or individuals wanting to participate.
- Q: Why are youth prizes not a part of this sale?
- A: This is to ensure you have more funds to support your unit programming.

Nuts for Scouting Selling & Safety Tips



- Always set a sales goal for yourself. If you reach your goal, set another one!
- Bring an extra pen with you and keep your order form as neat as possible.
- Always wear your "Class A" Scout uniform. Everyone loves a Scout in uniform!
- Always sell with another Scout AND an adult.
- Always walk on sidewalks and driveways, stay off the grass.
- Always act like a Scout, be polite, kind, and courteous.
- Always wear a smile & tell people why you are selling the product.
- Know the different types of products you are selling.
- Do not carry large amounts of cash with you.
- Never enter anyone's house, even if invited.
- Not every house will buy, so don't become discouraged.

- Always say, "Thank You", even if they do not buy.

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
