



Wisconsin DNR Boat Safety Certification



Registration Deadline: June 16, 2022, **Limit** 30, **FEE** \$10, payable at first session, cash or check payable to the Marathon County Sheriff's Office (Boat Safety)

Dates: June 20, 21, and 23, 2022; 6:00-9:00 p.m. Saturday, June 25, 8:00 AM to 2:00 PM Marathon County Sheriff's Office Training and Resource Center, 7255 Stewart Ave, Wausau and Lake Wausau (bring a snack)

NOTE: Scouts must attend **all** four sessions and the entire scheduled time. There are no make-up sessions. A parent must attend about the first 15 minutes of the first session and for the fourth session. This course is only open to Boy Scouts. Parents of Scouts who wish to complete the course may also participate. A Boat Safety Certificate is required for anyone born after January 1, 1989 to operate a boat in Wisconsin.

Eligibility: All Scouts are eligible. Scouts must have passed BSA Swimmers Test prior to beginning of course.

Bring to Each Session: Your Motor Boating Merit Badge Book may be purchased at the Scout Shop, 3511 Camp Phillips Road, Weston. The merit badge book is not required but is a good source of information. Only Scouts dressed in **PROPERLY** worn Scout uniform will be permitted to participate. DNR Boat Safety Booklet will be provided at the first session and must be brought to each session.

Prior to First Session: (1) Read the Motor Boating Merit Badge Book. (2) Contact the WI DNR to obtain Customer Identification Number by either calling 1-888-936-7463 between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m., or visit the DNR's Service Center during their regular business hours (this is a WI DNR requirement). This ID number must be brought to class.

To Register, Complete (1) Register On-Line at Samoset.org Doubleknot,(2) Merit Badge Application (blue card), (3) the Registration Form below after you register with the Council, give both forms to either your Advancement Chairman or Scoutmaster, who will forward them to **Mr. Dennis Blaser, 815 1st St, Rothschild, WI 54474** prior to the above deadline.

NOTE: If for whatever reason you are unable to attend one or more sessions, you **MUST** call Mr. Blaser (not you Scoutmaster) at 715-571-6389 before that session. If a Scout fails to do so, he will be ineligible to attend - all Council Merit Badge Clinics for one year.
